Independent Léger Survey: Falco Horne 5

3 Main Findings

01. Support



Nearly three out of four people support the Falco Horne 5 project. This represents clear majority support in Rouyn-Noranda (72%) and Abitibi-Témiscamingue (74%), primarily due to its economic and employment benefits.

02. Trust

73 %

Concerns remain regarding the environmental and social impact, however a large majority of respondents (73%) trust that the company will collaborate with civil society stakeholders to properly implement the project.

03. Common good

74 %

74% of respondents believe the project should move forward for the common good, even though some criticize it.

Other Findings

Project Awareness

 69% of Rouyn-Noranda residents were aware of the project at the time of the survey.

Support for the Project

- **73**% of respondents support the project (28% strongly in favor, 46% somewhat in favor, exceptionally high rates).
- Only 15% are opposed.

Main Reasons for Support

- **47%:** Job creation.
- 26%: Positive impact on the local economy.

Key Perceptions

- 86% believe the project will have a positive economic impact.
- 80% think mining projects strengthen regional pride.
- **73**% trust Falco to make the project acceptable and compliant with applicable societal and environmental expectations.
- 61% believe Falco will take public opinion into account.
